CONDITIONS OF LICENCE

1. This license [***] shall be kept on the approved premises and shall be produced on the request of an Inspector appointed under the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940.
2. Any change in the technical staff shall be forth with reported to the Licensing Authority.
3. If the Licensee wants to manufacture for sale additional items he should apply to the Licensing Authority for the necessary endorsement to the license as provided in Rule 138(3). The Licence shall be deemed to extend to the Cosmetics so endorsed.
1. The licensee shall inform the Licensing Authority in writing in the event of any change in the constitution of the firm operating under the license. Where any change in the constitution of the firm takes place, the current license shall be deemed to be valid for a maximum period of three months from the date on which the change takes place unless, in the meantime, a fresh license has been taken from the Licensing Authority in the name of the firm with the changed Constitution.
